Disability Sports:

This week the children in Key Stage 2 have been introduced to a range of disability sports by Mr Haslam, one of which was Boccia, which is a Paralympic sport that tests muscle control and accuracy. Players propel balls to land close to a target ball. Two sides compete over a set number of ends. Each side has six balls (red or blue) each end to try and score points. Points are accumulated over the course of a match to find a winner.

The children quickly picked up the skills needed to play and started to develop tactics which lead to some very exciting and close matches.

Last night we took 4 players from New York and Frithville to take part in a table tennis tournament at Thomas Middlecott Academy. It was an exciting evening and some great table tennis was played.
