Summer Term:

What an amazing Term we have ahead... We hope you have all had a fabulous Easter and are enjoying our current good weather!

Class 1:

In Class 1 our Science topic is plants. If anyone has any seeds, bulbs, plants, pots or other gardening items they can donate we will be most appreciative. For English we are looking at poetry, information texts and fairy tales. We will be reading different versions of 'Jack and the beanstalk' and growing our own. In Maths one of the areas we will be studying is time. Can you please talk with your children about different things you do with them on different days/months/seasons, and if relevant practise telling the time. In History and Geography we will be learning about Mary Seacole. A lot of other areas will be covered too.

Class 2:

Class 2 have begun the term with the theme of dragons, linking with English, our Chinese cultural day today and St George's Day on Monday. In science we are finishing our work about life-cycles and moving on to the topic of sound. Our maths work will cover a variety of topics. Many of the children in younger year groups are currently focussing on money; any practice they can have with calculating totals and change in real-life situations will be very helpful. SATs week for Year 6 begins on 14th May 2018. Finally, a huge thank you to the children who have volunteered to take part in the Samba display at the Parish Council Open Meeting on Monday!
