**Did you know?**

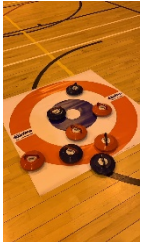
May is the fifth month of the year in the Julian and Gregorian calendar and consists of 31 days. May is named after the Greek goddess Maia.

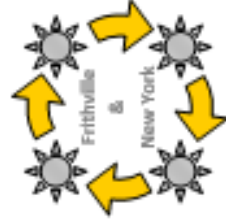
