This Half Term...

Class 1:

This half-term we will continue to learn about castles. We will also be learning about Queen Elizabeth I. In science we continue looking at materials and also seasons. In RE we will be working on Christianity and look forward to the lead up to Christmas. In maths, we will be studying place value, addition and subtraction, length, multiplication and division, and shape. We have new role play areas and are very excited to use our imagination with our new boat.

Class 2:

This half-term Class 2 will be studying various elements of grammar and punctuation and applying them to longer pieces of writing that will include a persuasive text. In science, they will be looking at the subject of solids, liquids and gases, and changing state. Years 3 and 4 will study Ancient Greece in history and Europe in geography. RE will again focus on Christianity, in particular beliefs about God.
