A huge thank you to all the parents who hear their children read regularly.

We know that reading is the single most important thing you can do to help your child's education (as well as learning their multiplication tables). It is best to read little and often, so try to put aside some time for it every day...

Read to your child every night, even if it's only a couple of pages. Sometimes, it is the last thing you feel like doing in the evening, but this is probably the most important way you can help your child get into reading and at the same time get them away from the electronic devices!
