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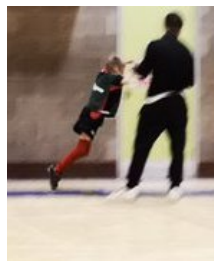

The Critters are back:

Advice for all...

Guidance that we are given and are obliged to follow...

Professionals working in schools and other organisations should be aware that a 'Severe and Persistent Infestation' of head lice or 'nits' (NICE, 2016) could be an indicator of serious welfare concerns for children and young people. This has been evidenced in serious case reviews.

It is very common for children and young people to get head lice and it can take time to completely treat the infestation, particularly if more than one member of the family is infested. However, a prolonged and persistent failure by parents or carers to treat the infestation is likely to be distressing for the child and could also indicate other welfare issues.
